# Title: Summit Station Skiway Reporting Procedure and Timeline for the Summer Season

**Purpose:** Define expectations, distribution and timeframe for Summit Station Skiway reports.

**Background:** Transportation of personnel and materials to Summit Station is supported by skied aircraft over the course of multiple flight periods each summer. A skiway report is provided to CPS personnel and the Air National Guard to assist with planning prior to each flight period. Additional information is provided pre-season to document condition of skiway, flags and grooming activity in preparation for flights

**Timeline:** The due dates are listed below. Dates are re-assigned annually to coincide with the flight calendar and flight period kick-off calls.

Summit will send reports on due dates no later than 9:00am local Summit (WGT) time.

## Pre-Season Reporting

The first report and photo documentation is scheduled for the completion of skiway construction work, and no later than the day prior to the first northbound LC-130, whichever occurs first.

Summit will provide:

- Skiway certification document with flagging portion filled out
- Photos:
  - Flags: Photos of the lowest flag
  - Flags: Photos of any in bad shape that cannot be repaired/replaced prior to opening
  - Skiway: Photo from a kneeling position
  - Skiway: Photo from top of equipment to provide aerial perspective



#### During Season Reporting

<u>Skiway Reports</u>: One week prior to the flight period, the Summit Site Supervisor will distribute the skiway report. 2016 due dates:
