General:

• Phase 2 and 3 celebrated Halloween on Thursday night, and Phase 2 departed on schedule on Friday afternoon.

Significant Weather Observations:

- 10/28 winds: calm; clear sky, fog
- 10/29 winds: 10kn, overcast, some ice
- 10/30 winds: 210 at 8 kn, SKC > FEW, intermittent fog
- 10/31 winds: 6 kn, SKC, extensive feathery rime on S sides of everything
- 11/01 winds: 9kn, clear sky
- 11/02 winds: calm, SKC > FEW with intermittent fog passing through station

• 11/03 winds 240 at 15 kn , becoming cloudy and snowing. Sonde showed significant WSW winds increasing to just below tropopause (different from last 8 days), humidity profile much more uniform
