The MSF appears under a great display of twilight stratocumulus on 12/11. SWD.

General:

• 12/6: Strong CAPABL scattering phenomenon, with many diffraction patterns projected onto snow surface, was present from at least 19:25 to 20:50z and likely beyond. A solar pillar effect was visible from artificial lights on Big House and Green House.

Significant Weather Observations:

- 12/5: Overcast stratus, freezing fog, ice particles, -22C, 17 kts.
- 12/6: Broken stratus, freezing fog, ice particles, -19C, 12 kts.
- 12/7: Broken stratocumulus, blowing snow, -23C, 20 kts.
- 12/8: Overcast stratocumulus, blowing snow, -22C, 18 kts. Lunar halo observed at 22:35z.
- 12/9: Few stratus, -31C, 12 kts.
- 12/10: Overcast stratus, -22C, 14 kts.
- 12/11: Broken altostratus, -21C, 11 kts.

- 12/5: Reported at 18:23z, MMCR observations of a clear sky do not match current conditions, which include perceptible falling ice crystals, and MPL observations of a liquid layer producing ice fall streaks.
- 12/6: At 01:36z, powered down MMCR. Waited several minutes, and then restored power. When MMCR resumed operation at 01:50z, signals from two distinct cloud layers were displayed. These matched MPL observations and visible conditions.
