- 03-22: Blsn, IC. Ovc altostratus. -32C, 17kts. 11:00Z: Halo.
- 03-23: Drsn, IC. Bkn altocumulus. -24C, 15 kts. 11:00-12:50Z: Halo 11:20Z- 22 degree halo, 46 degree halo, upper tangent arc, circumzenithal arc, and column.
- 03-24: -SG, IC, drsn. Bkn altostratus, ove cirrocumulus. -26C, 13kts. 11:00-13:00Z: Halo. 18:00Z: Halo
- 03-25: Few altostratus. -33C, 10kts. Very small (<0.5cm in diameter) yukimarimo forming downwind of frosted instruments and buildings.
- 03-26: Skc. -42C, 0kts. 11:00-1800: Fata morgana.
